### **REPORT**

 $\underline{\text{MOLANDS}}$  Improved on last week but still not in the best form. The water has gone clear and light lines with natural baits have really started to come into play especially for the F1s. Maggot or caster fished down the first shelf at five metres is the top tactic for F1s to 5lb in nets to over 100lb. Carp to double figures are still coming to bomb and pellet /pellet feeder or off the top. Best pegs are 2, 10 - 13, 21 - 25, 33, 41 - 46 and 58 - 60.

<u>GEARYS</u> The catches have been down but the quality of the fish coming out is great with lots of fish into double figures and up to 19lb have featured in nets this week. Bomb and pellet, method feeder or surface tactics have accounted for the better catches. The skimmers are still being caught although nets to 40lb have been best and they are only showing on a few pegs with 7 - 13 and 31 - 35 the best areas for them and pole fished caster, maggot or corn are working best.

<u>LITTLE GEARYS</u> Like all the pools the fishing has been a little harder than expected but Little Gearys is the most consistent at the moment with catches to over 100lb and lots of decent nets. Pegs 1 – 10 have been in the best form and pole fished pellet, paste or meat either down the edges or long at 13 metres. Method feeder to the island is also catching a few.

<u>WILLOW</u> Pleasure anglers have enjoyed good sport on Willow throughout the week with plenty of carp, F1s, skimmers and crucians showing on all pegs. A small feeder fished to the island, pellet waggler or pole with pellet, meat or corn have all worked well.

<u>SIBLINGS A</u> This pool has been a little bit patchy but plenty of F1s, ide, carp and skimmers are showing. On the wider pegs a small pellet feeder has been working, on the other areas, long pole with meat or banded hard pellet has been best. Good nets of ide are coming to caster fished shallow.

<u>SIBLINGS B</u> Prolific for F1s albeit small in the 8oz -1lb range but anglers have enjoyed a bite a chuck on the best days this week. Pole fished paste, pellet or maggot all accounting for good catches with pegs 5 – 12 the pick of the pegs at the moment.

ANNIVERSARIES Not been in the best form this week with F1s to 2lb making up catches to around 40lb best. The early pegs from 1 – 10 have been best with pole and pellet or caster the top tactic. Pegs 1 and 2 have been providing a few bigger carp with meat or corn fished tight across to the far bank catching fish to 15lb.
